Learn practical environmental physiology, biochemistry and molecular biology skills in Greece!

The location: Greece is a country in southeastern Europe with thousands of islands throughout the Aegean and Ionian seas. It is the cradle of Western civilization and is credited with the creation of democracy, political science, historiography, the Olympic Games, Western philosophy, drama, and literature. In this field experience, students will be based at the University of Thessaly in the city of Trikala. Trips to Athens, to the popular island of Skiathos, to the UNESCO World Heritage site of Meteora, and to other sites have been planned.

Course Work and Highlights: The course will focus on learning practical skills in the areas of environmental physiology, biochemistry, and molecular biology. Students will complete a group project in one of the three areas with the help of a group mentor. Four 2-hour discussions focused specifically on personal and professional development have been planned at various locations throughout the 2-week period. The course will also be complimented by traditional Greek experiences that include a visit to Meteora for a guided tour through the monasteries, a guided tour through Acropolis in Athens, an overnight trip to Pilio Mountain, and a trip to the beautiful island of Skiathos.

Housing: Housing will be in hotels, with double occupancy or larger groups.

Prerequisite course: Students must take or have taken BIO 144, EXS252, CHM102 and/or CHM108.
