ACADEMICS

Approximately 17% of all courses taught at Soongsil University are in English. While Korean is used in the majority of departments, there are several programs in which a large majority of classes are taught in English: Lifelong Education, Christian Studies, English Language and Literature, Business Management and Media. Exchange students may take up to 19 credits per semester. Normally, one course is awarded 2 to 3 credits. You will be able to register for your courses upon your arrival. In addition, all international students are offered leveled Korean language classes in the evening free of charge. These classes provide an excellent opportunity to improve Korean language skills and understand Korean culture. They will help students understand and use familiar expressions in everyday situations, which will help them make real life connections in Korea outside of the classroom.

Soongsil University offers a unique opportunity for students to spend their summer in Korea and an East Asian country such as the Philippines. The program focuses on the International Development Cooperation and consists of two parts: East Asian/Korean Studies in Seoul, Korea + Field Work in Korea or East Asian countries. Students will not only gain knowledge in East Asia and Korea, but also invaluable hands-on volunteer experience by participating the program.

STUDENT SERVICES & ACTIVITIES

There are over 100 clubs and societies on campus, ranging from social and recreation to religious and cultural groups. Campus Life at Soongsil University runs a number of leadership, training, community engagement and environmental programs designed to give you the chance to learn new things and apply yourself to real world challenges.

In addition to clubs and societies, Soongsil organizes social and representative team sports competitions plus a range of outdoor activities.
