# Summer 2019:

## Greece

### Discovery Course



### The Locations:

Greece is a country in southeastern Europe with thousands of islands throughout the Aegean and Ionian seas. It is the cradle of Western civilization and is credited with the creation of democracy, political science, historiography, the Olympic Games, Western philosophy, drama, and literature. In this field experience, students will be based at the University of Thessaly in the city of Trikala. Excursions to Athens, to the popular island of Skiathos, to the UNESCO World Heritage site of Meteora, and other planned sites.

### Coursework and Highlights:

This course will focus on learning practical skills in the areas of environmental physiology, biochemistry, and molecular biology. Students will complete a group project in one of the three areas with the help of a group mentor. Four of the 2-hour discussions focused with the help of a group mentor. Four of the 2-hour discussions focused on specifically personal and professional development have been planned at various locations throughout the 2-week period. The course will also be complemented by traditional Greek experiences that include a visit to Meteora for a guided tour through the monasteries, a guided tour through Acropolis in Athens, an overnight trip to Pilio Mountain, and a trip to the beautiful island of Skiathos.

### Housing:

Students will stay in double rooms in local hotels with double occupancy for larger groups.

### Prerequisite Course:

Students must take or have taken BIO144, EXS252, CHM102, and/or CHM108.
